K-12 Guidelines for Uniform and Dress Code





GENERAL RATIONALE FOR A DRESS CODE

- 1. Being overly concerned with clothing and outward appearances is contrary to God's will for us as revealed in Scripture (1 Sam 16:7; Matt 6:19-21; James 4:4; 1 John 2:15-17).
- 2. Pressures felt by children to compete in areas of dress are destructive to the unity of the school and the body of Christ.
- 3. Everything in our lives, including our clothing, should reflect the order of the Godhead and the order He has created in the world (1 Cor. 14:40).
- 4. Clothing should be modest and not draw attention to the individual (1 Tim 2:9), and should reflect differences in the sexes (Deut. 22:5).
- 5. Our children are serving as witnesses and ambassadors both for the Lord Jesus Christ and the school. Student appearance is a reflection of both.

SPECIFIC RATIONALE FOR UNIFORMS

- 1. Uniforms are a positive discipline in the school, and Stonehaven emphasizes the value of a disciplined learning environment. Just as dressing up, and wearing career specific uniforms, is a part of the workday for parents, wearing a school uniform is a signal to the child that it is time for hard work and studious activity.
- 2. Uniforms prevent problems associated with the subjective interpretation of a dress code policy. Uniforms will eliminate any confusion about what is acceptable, modest, and appropriate by the school's standards.
- 3. Uniforms tend to decrease the cost of student clothing. Our uniform vendors provide economical and durable items. Often parents need only purchase two or three sets of uniforms to last throughout the school year, and often these items can be handed down to other children.

UNIFORM AND DRESS CODE ENFORCEMENT

The school faculty and administration will enforce the Uniform and Dress Code. Interpretation and application of the Uniform and Dress Code standards will be the responsibility of the administration. Students not complying with the Uniform and Dress Code will be required to rectify their appearance immediately. Cheerful, consistent compliance is expected. Students who violate the Uniform and Dress Code, either by action or by challenging and rebellious attitudes, will be subject to disciplinary actions.

LOWER SCHOOL GIRLS DAILY WEAR







LE light blue or navy long sleeve, short sleeve, or peter pan polo with Stonehaven logo



LE khaki skirt, Lands' End or Old Navy khaki shorts or pants. Black or brown belts must be worn with shorts or pants (1st-6th grade, optional for Kindergarten). Skirt and short length must be 3" above the knee or longer. LE navy or gray Ponte jumper with Stonehaven logo worn with polo. Must be worn with privacy shorts.



LE navy short or long sleeve dresses with Stonehaven logo. Must be worn with privacy shorts.



Optional, but only uniform items can be worn in the classroom. LE navy cardigan, sweater vest, sweatshirt, or fleece with Stonehaven logo



Solid white or navy crew socks, knee socks, or tights. Leggings are not permitted. Solid color brown, navy or black leather shoes or sneakers that rest at or below the ankle and which are predominantly one color: white, black, navy, or gray. (See pg. 16 for more specific shoe guidelines)

LOWER SCHOOL GIRLS CHAPEL WEAR



K - 3RD GRADE

- LE Plaid Jumper and Peter Pan blouse with S logo on collar. Length must be 3" above the knee or longer.
- Privacy shorts required.
- Only LE cardigan, sweater vest, and fleece can be worn inside the school building.
- Solid color brown, navy or black leather, saddle oxfords or suede shoes.
- Optional: navy, light blue or white hair bow or headband that matches the uniform.
- Solid navy flat knit or opaque knee socks or solid navy tights. Patterns are allowed (i.e., cable knit).
- No white socks on Chapel Day.



4TH-6TH GRADE

- LE plaid or gray box pleat skirt and white Oxford shirt with S logo. Length must be 3" above the knee or longer.
- Privacy shorts required.
- Only LE cardigan, sweater vest, and fleece can be worn inside the school building.
- Solid color brown, navy or black leather, saddle oxfords or suede shoes.
- Optional: navy, light blue or white hair bow or headband that matches the uniform.
- Solid navy flat knit or opaque knee socks or solid navy Tights. Patterns are allowed (i.e., cable knit).
- No white socks on Chapel Day.

^{*}Chapel items are permitted any day, but required on Chapel Day.

LOWER SCHOOL BOYS DAILY WEAR



LE navy or light blue short sleeve or long sleeve polo with Stonehaven logo.



Lands' End or Old Navy khaki shorts or pants. Black or brown belt required 1st-6th grade, (optional for Kindergarten).



Optional, but only uniform items can be worn in the classroom. Navy cardigan, pullover, vest, sweatshirt, or fleece with Stonehaven logo



White, black, or navy solid color socks.

Solid color brown, navy or black leather shoes or sneakers that rest at or below the ankle and which are predominantly one color: white, black, navy, or gray. (see pg. 16 for more specific shoe guidelines)

LOWER SCHOOL BOYS CHAPEL WEAR



K - 6TH GRADE

- LE gray slacks† and white short sleeve or long sleeve Oxford shirt with S Logo.
- Solid brown or black leather belt. LE navy tie.
- Only LE cardigan, sweater vest, and fleece can be worn inside the school building.
- Solid color brown, navy or black leather or suede shoes.
- Black or navy dress socks.
- No white socks on Chapel Day.

†For the 2025–2026 school year, we will be transitioning the chapel pants to the School Uniform Mens Active Performance Chino Pants.

*Chapel wear is permitted any day, but required on Chapel Day.

LOWER SCHOOL P.E. UNIFORM BOYS AND GIRLS



$K-6^{TH}$ GRADE

- Any Stonehaven t-shirt
- Only LE fleece and Stonehaven sweatshirts are allowed.
- LE navy mesh shorts or LE navy athletic pants†.
- Athletic "tights" or leggings are not permitted.
- White or black crew socks.
- Appropriate athletic shoes, any color (no characters).

†For the 2025-2026 school year, we will be transitioning the P.E. pants to the LE School Uniform Jogger Sweatpants.

UPPER SCHOOL GIRLS DAILY WEAR







LE navy, light blue, gray, or white short sleeve or long sleeve polo with Stonehaven logo.









LE khaki or navy skirt, shorts, or pants. Skirt/short length must be 3" above the knee or longer. Skirts must be worn with privacy shorts (can be purchased anywhere)









Optional, but only uniform items can be worn in the classroom. Navy cardigan, sweater vest, fleece, sweatshirt and athletic jacket with Stonehaven logo











Solid white or navy crew socks, knee socks, or tights. Leggings are not permitted.

Solid color brown, navy or black leather or suede shoes. Sneakers that rest at or below the ankle and which are predominantly one color: white, black, brown, navy, or gray.

(see pg 15 for more specific shoe guidelines).

UPPER SCHOOL GIRLS CHAPEL WEAR



7TH-12TH GRADE

- LE plaid or gray box-pleat skirt and white short sleeve or long sleeve Oxford shirt (logo not required). Skirt length must be 3" above the knee or longer. Optional: navy, light blue or white hair bow or headband that matches the uniform.
- **SWEATERS ARE REQUIRED in Chapel.** Navy cardigan, pullover, or vest with Stonehaven logo.
- Sweatshirts, fleece, and athletic jackets are not permitted at all on this day.
- Navy or black privacy shorts (to be worn under skirt and not visible). Must be solid, no stripes.
- Solid navy flat knit or opaque knee socks or solid navy tights. Patterns are allowed (i.e., cable knit).
- No white socks on Chapel Day.
- Solid color brown, navy, or black leather or suede shoes (Mary Jane, Saddle Oxford, Merrells, Sperry, Bucs or Loafers). No heels, boots, or high tops.

UPPER SCHOOL BOYS DAILY WEAR



LE navy, light blue, gray, or white short sleeve or long sleeve polo with Stonehaven logo.



LE khaki or navy shorts or pants. Belts required. Black or brown leather only.



Optional, but only uniform items can be worn in the classroom. Navy cardigan, sweater vest, fleece, sweatshirt and athletic jacket with Stonehaven logo



White or black solid color socks. Leather or suede shoes that are solid color brown, navy, or black, or sneakers that rest at or below the ankle and which are predominantly one color: white, black, brown, navy, or gray (see pg 15 for specific shoe guidelines).

UPPER SCHOOL BOYS CHAPEL WEAR



7TH-12TH GRADE

- LE gray slacks† and white short sleeve or long sleeve Oxford shirt (logo not required).
- LE navy tie, LE navy blazer only (no logo required). Black or brown belt.
- Solid color brown, navy, or black leather or suede shoes.
- Black or navy dress socks.
- BLAZERS REQUIRED in Chapel.
- Sweatshirts, fleece, and athletic jackets are not permitted at all on this day.
- No white socks on Chapel Day

^{*}Chapel wear is permitted any day, but required on Chapel Day.

7TH-8TH GRADE P.E. UNIFORM BOYS AND GIRLS



- Any Stonehaven t-shirt.
- Sweatshirts optional, but only Stonehaven logo fleece and sweatshirts are allowed.
- LE navy mesh shorts (must be fingertip length) or LE navy athletic pants.
- Athletic "tights" or leggings are not permitted.
- White or black crew socks.
- Appropriate athletic shoes, any color (no characters).

For the 2025-2026 school year, we will be transitioning the P.E. pants to the LE School Uniform Jogger Sweatpants.

SHOES



CHAPEL AND DAILY WEAR
Solid color brown, navy, or black leather or suede shoes
(Mary Jane, Saddle Oxford, Merrells, Sperry, Bucs, or Loafers).



DAILY WEAR AND PE

Sneakers that rest at or below the ankle and which are predominantly one color: white, black, navy, or gray. Alternate color must also be white, black, navy, or gray. For example, a navy shoe with a white stripe is acceptable. A navy shoe with red on the back is not acceptable. No heels, boots, or high tops. Laces should also be one color.

P.E. shoes can be any color.

STONEHAVEN UNIFORM GUIDELINES

SHIRTS

Shirts are to be tucked in at all times. "Blousing" of shirts is not permitted. Approved sweatshirts and sweaters must be worn with a collared uniform shirt underneath. Long sleeve t-shirts are not permitted under the uniform polo. Short-sleeve undershirts, if worn, must be white.

COATS

Winter coats may be purchased from any store but must be solid color navy, black, white, gray, or charcoal. No denim, characters, logos, or designs permitted. Coats and letterman jackets are not to be worn inside the building. Refer to grade-specific guidelines for sweaters and jackets approved for indoors.

ACCESSORIES

- **Jewelry:** Jewelry should not be a distraction from the uniform. Gold, silver or jewelry that matches the school uniform colors is acceptable.
- Hair Accessories: Navy, light blue or white hair bow or headband that matches the uniform is acceptable.

SPIRIT DAYS

- On designated Spirit Days (generally once/month), students may wear a Stonehaven t-shirt or Stonehaven uniform polo. Stonehaven Spirit Shirts and other t-shirts are available for purchase in the school store.
- Students may wear uniform shorts, PE bottoms or jeans with no holes, tears, stains, logos, or characters. Shorts must meet the "fingertip" test for length.
- No sweatpants, joggers, leggings, or pajama pants.
- House jersey or colors are permitted only on days designated as such. House jerseys are not a part of Spirit Wear, but should follow Spirit Wear guidelines for modesty on designated days.

GENERAL GUIDELINES

- All uniform items must contain the student's name.
- Clothing may be selected to permit reasonable growing room, but extreme over-sizing is not permitted.
- Tattoos are not permitted.
- K-4th girls may wear earring "studs," with nothing hanging below the ear lobe. 5th-12th girls may wear studs or tasteful drop earrings, no larger than 12mm. Boys 5th-12th grades may wear chain necklaces that are tucked into the collar. Necklaces and bracelets should not be visible. This is as much a safety concern as it is a uniform concern. Piercings and earrings are not permitted on boys.
- Nail color is permitted on girls only if it does not become a distraction.
- Excessive make-up and face art are not permitted. Skin care must match skin tone.
- Unnaturally colored/dyed (e.g., blue) hair is not permitted.
- Hair must be neatly groomed and conservatively styled. Boys' hair must be short enough that the eyebrows, top of the collar, and bottom of the ear are always visible.
- Any outlandish or distracting clothing, jewelry, make-up, hairstyle or appearance will not be permitted.
- Student apparel and school gear (e.g. backpacks, lunch containers, notebooks, etc.) shall not display any commercial slogans, product promotions, celebrity representations, or any pictures/cartoons of commercial characters.

The school faculty and administration will enforce the Uniform and Dress Code. Students not complying with the Uniform and Dress Code will be required to rectify their appearance immediately. Cheerful, consistent compliance is expected. Students who violate the Uniform and Dress Code, either by action or by challenging and rebellious attitudes, will be subject to disciplinary actions. If repeated or extreme violations occur, parents will be contacted to correct the violation immediately. Students will not be permitted on field trips without proper uniform attire.

UPPER SCHOOL CASUAL WEAR AND FREE DRESS GUIDELINES

CASUAL WEAR DAYS

- On designated Casual Wear days, students may wear a Stonehaven t-shirt or uniform polo with jeans.
- Jeans (blue, black, white) must have no rips, tears, holes, or embellishments (embroidery, jewels, art of any kind).
- Uniform bottoms are also permitted (khaki pants, shorts, skirts).
- Shorts must meet the fingertip test for length.
- No sweatpants, joggers, leggings or pajama pants.
- Leggings may only be worn under a skirt or shorts; no leggings as pants. When leggings are worn under a skirt or shorts, the top layer must still meet the fingertip test for length.

FREE DRESS DAY

Free Dress Days will occur periodically in 7th -12th grades. The privilege of free dress participation will be earned by each student through uniform compliance.

- Neat and respectable shirts, tops or dresses. Nothing skintight or overly revealing.
- No sleeveless tops, tank tops, or crop tops.
- Neat and respectable pants, jeans, skirts, or shorts, not tight-fitting.
- Skirts or shorts need to meet the fingertip test for length.
- Any distressing or modifications of clothing must not reveal skin (holes, rips, ties).
- No inappropriate/offensive slogans.
- Shoes should be sufficient for outdoor activity.
